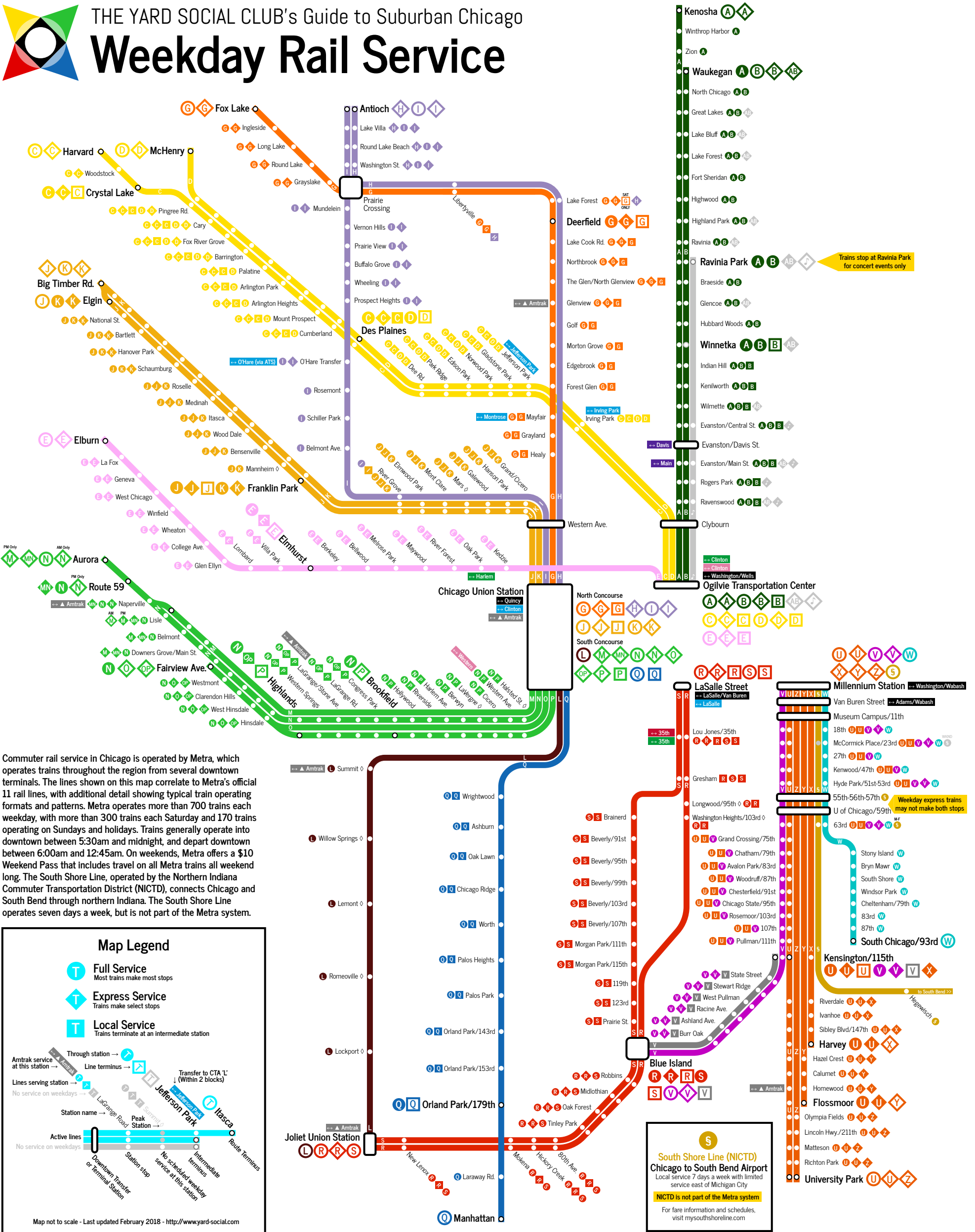




# Weekday Rail Service



Commuter rail service in Chicago is operated by Metra, which operates trains throughout the region from several downtown terminals. The lines shown on this map correlate to Metra's official 11 rail lines, with additional detail showing typical train operating formats and patterns. Metra operates more than 700 trains each weekday, with more than 300 trains each Saturday and 170 trains operating on Sundays and holidays. Trains generally operate into downtown between 5:30am and midnight, and depart downtown between 6:00am and 12:45am. On weekends, Metra offers a \$10 Weekend Pass that includes travel on all Metra trains all weekend long. The South Shore Line, operated by the Northern Indiana Commuter Transportation District (NICTD), connects Chicago and South Bend through northern Indiana. The South Shore Line operates seven days a week, but is not part of the Metra system.

    - AB** Limited express service on Saturdays and Sundays

    - MN** Peak period express service Monday through Saturday (Downers Grove/Main St. - Aurora)
    - N** Express service during weekday peak period (Naperville + Route 59, + Aurora in AM Peak)
    - OP** Express service during weekday peak period (Hinsdale - Fairview Ave.)
    - P** Express service during weekday peak period (Congress Park - Fairview Ave.)

- Lake Shore Corridor (Metra Electric)**
    - U** Chicago to University Park: Local service 7 days a week

    - U** Weekday local peak service to Kensington/115th
    - X** Express service during weekday peak period (Kensington - Harvey)
    - Y** Express service during weekday peak period (Hazel Crest - Flossmoor)
    - Z** Express service during weekday peak period (Olympia Fields - University Park)
  - Chicago to Blue Island via Hyde Park**: Local service Monday through Saturday
  - V** Express service during weekday peak period
