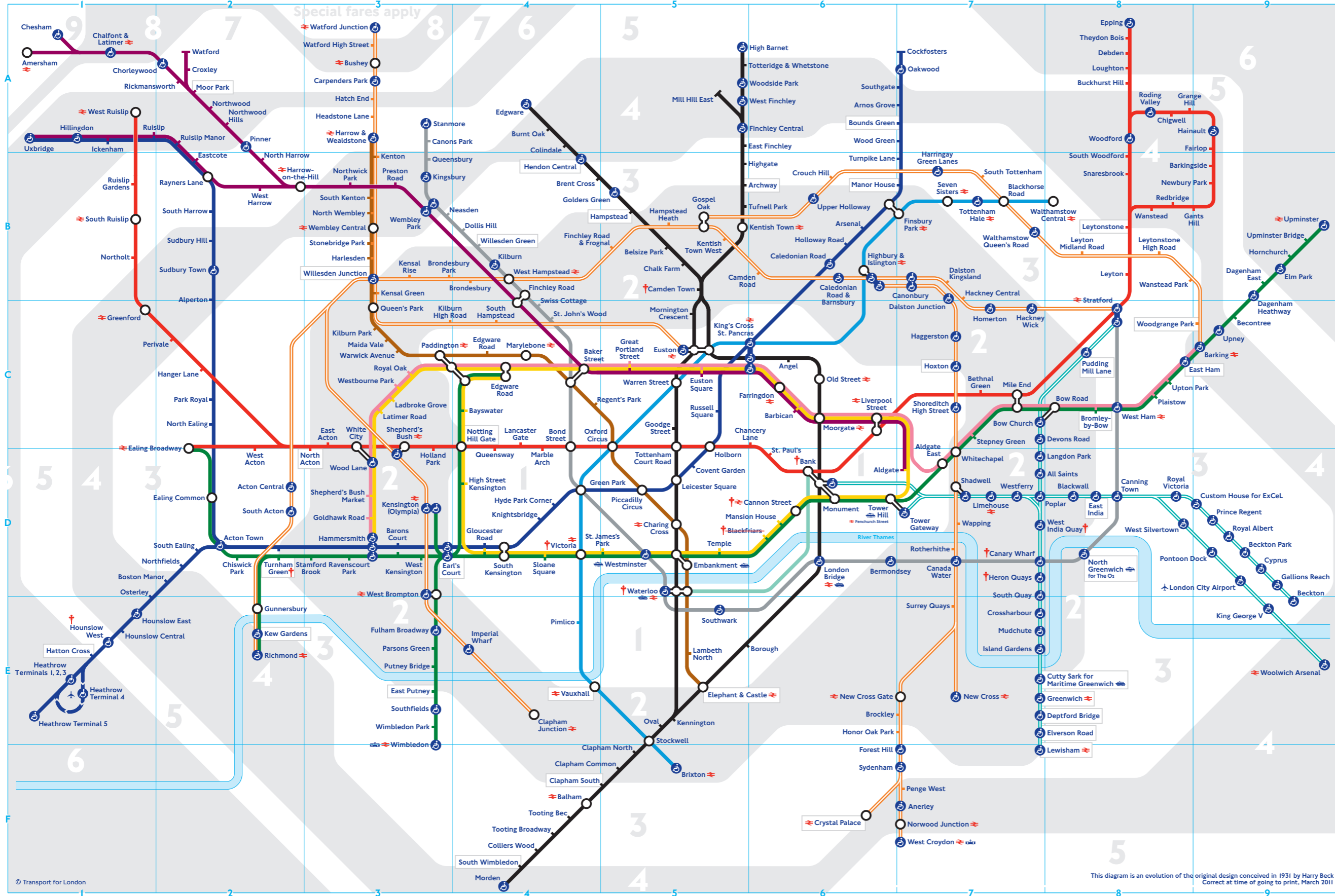


# Tube map

<b>Bank</b>	Waterloo & City line open 0615 until 2148 Mondays to Fridays and 0800 until 1830 Saturdays, and closed Sundays and Public Holidays
<b>Blackfriars</b>	Underground station closed until late 2011
<b>Camden Town</b>	From 1300 until 1730 Sundays open for interchange and exit only
<b>Canary Wharf</b>	Step-free interchange between Underground, Canary Wharf DLR and Heron Quays DLR stations at street level
<b>Cannon Street</b>	Open until 2100 Mondays to Fridays. Closed Saturdays and Sundays
<b>Heron Quays</b>	Step-free interchange between Heron Quays and Canary Wharf Underground station at street level
<b>Hounslow West</b>	Step-free access for wheelchair users only
<b>Turnham Green</b>	Served by Piccadilly line trains early mornings and late evenings only
<b>Victoria</b>	Major escalator refurbishment works until early 2012. Use nearby stations or alternative routes
<b>Waterloo</b>	Waterloo & City line open 0615 until 2148 Mondays to Fridays and 0800 until 1830 Saturdays, and closed Sundays and Public Holidays
<b>West India Quay</b>	Not served by DLR trains from Bank towards Lewisham at peak times
